

# Tangier Tales

History that is Tangier



## Alpheus Hugh Hipple - Potentate 1906

In the late evening hours of Saturday July 29, 1933, a ringing telephone pierced the silence of the Lyle home located at 5106 Webster Street, in Omaha Nebraska. The caller had news, but little specific information. Dorothy and husband Donald Lyle left at once, destination Canada....

Canada was not yet a federated nation in 1865 and the American Civil War had not yet reached its conclusion. It was in Ontario Canada on February 25, 1865, Alpheus Hugh Hipple, or A. Hugh Hipple as he was known, was born. He grew up alongside six siblings, in the family of Jacob and Mary (Fry) Hipple. Jacob was a farmer and schoolteacher. There is little doubt A. Hugh's desire for education and intellectual pursuits, as well as his love of fishing have their roots in his childhood home. There were opportunities for both. Upon graduation from primary school, it was on to University for A. Hugh. He would pursue a career in dentistry.

1889 saw A. Hugh graduated by the Royal College of Dental Surgeons at Toronto, Canada. Shortly thereafter, he pursued and received, via a special examination, a Doctoral Degree of Dental Surgery. Dr. Hipple was 24 years old and looking forward to a successful career.

Over the next three years, Dr. Hipple established a dental practice at Stratford, Ontario. It was during this time that he began to consider establishing himself, and his practice, in the United States.

Dr. Hipple left his country of birth in 1892 and settled in Omaha Nebraska. He was an intelligent and eager young man and he knew that Omaha, not yet 40 years old, would have need of his services. By 1895 he had associated himself with Creighton University as a member of the medical faculty and lecturer on oral surgery.

Having established a successful dental practice and teaching career, it was time for a trip to his native Canada. The trip would allow Dr. Hipple to visit his family and visit a certain young lady named Emma Jane Pritchard. The couple were married January 1, 1896, in Leeds, Ontario, Canada.

Twins joined A. Hugh and Emma on July 12, 1899. Sadly, one of the twins did not survive and was buried at Forest Lawn Cemetery on July 13, 1899. Their daughter, Dorothy Maude Hipple, would survive and enjoy 98 years before her death on January 19, 1998.

His practice and students were very important to Dr. Hipple; however, he and Emma did make time for rest and relaxation. The family routinely vacationed at the Summer Colony of Fernbank on the St. Lawrence River near Brockville, Ontario. Often, these fishing trips would be a month, or even six weeks, in duration.

Throughout the nineteen teens, twenties and thirties, Dr. Hipple continued to teach and enjoy a well-respected dental practice. He maintained his intellectual curiosity throughout his life, as well as his on-going commitment to his community. He was a frequent speaker and editorial writer, with many articles appearing in the Omaha World Herald. He spoke and wrote on issues affecting the citizens of Omaha and on local politics, in general. In 1917, A. Hugh was appointed Army Dental Examiner of applicants to the Army Dental Reserve Corps. By 1922, he was Dean of the Creighton Dental College, President of the National Dental Teachers' Association and was elected President of the National Dental Faculty Association.

July 30, 1933, Dorothy and Donald Lyle arrived in Canada. There they found Mrs. Hipple distraught and waiting for their arrival. She was able to give her daughter and son-in-law additional details.

Dr. Hipple and Mrs. Hipple had been vacationing at Fernbank on the St. Lawrence River. It was Dr. Hipple's habit to fish alone in a rowboat, usually sitting in a cane chair. When Dr. Hipple left, late Saturday afternoon, he remarked to Mrs. Hipple that he planned to fish until after dark and she shouldn't worry if he arrived home later than expected.

Dr. Hipple had not returned by late Saturday evening and a search involving authorities from both New York and Canada, covering both sides of the river, was initiated. By mid-day Sunday, Dr. Hipple's rowboat was found 11 miles down the St. Lawrence River and dragging operations continued.

It was determined that Dr. Hipple had fallen out of his boat and was drowned. Residents stated the river was very rough Saturday afternoon and the temperatures were high, as well. It was thought that Dr. Hipple either fainted due to the heat and fell overboard or due to rough waters was thrown from the boat.

Dr. Hipple laid down his working tools on July 29, 1933, at age 68 years. His gravesite is in the Protestant Cemetery at Brockville, Ontario Canada.




