


## Annual Festival of Trees Update

The health and safety of our guests and volunteers are a primary concern. The short and long term financial risks were also considered.


We are already working toward coming back in 2021 with a spectacular Festival of Trees!



# Potentate's Message

## SAD NEWS

As most have either read or have heard your Tangier Divan, after consultation with the event Chairmen, has reluctantly decided to cancel the 2020 Fesztival of Trees.



There was no single reason for this decision. Financial risk, whether from canceling or proceeding, was carefully considered, as was the potential health risk to our volunteers and guests. Not to be overlooked is the long-term risk to the Fesztival and Tangier itself if we went ahead this year and things went very wrong. We greatly appreciate the many volunteers who helped with baking and decorating our Fesztival cookies. Be assured that plans are being made for the sale of those delicious cookies in the very near future.

With the recommendations from the State of Nebraska and Douglas County Health Department again being more limiting, our rooms will be organized with these guidelines in effect. Social distancing recommendations have been established by the State and County Health Departments. I must remind all that we are required to wear face masks. In our lounge area, seating is limited to 8 people per table. You must be seated eating or drinking to remove your mask. If you are up moving around or at the bar ordering a drink, then your mask is required to be worn. The requirement for social distancing is highly recommended.

Sadly, the Ceremonial that was scheduled for December 12 is also being canceled. After having a lengthy discussion with the Ceremonial Team, this decision was made with the understanding that our new nobles would not receive the experience that they have earned and deserve if we proceeded.

In times of uncertainty, our strong fraternal bonds lift and support us in ways we could not have imagined. During this unprecedented worldwide health crisis, we are concerned about the health of our families, our fraternal family, our communities, our Shriners Hospitals patients, families and staff, and of course, ourselves.

Be safe, take care of your health, our families, our fraternal family, our communities and follow the advice of our Federal and State authorities during these difficult times. Hopefully we will get through this soon and life as we knew it can get back to normal.



I would like to extend a big thank you to all the Nobles and ladies who joined us for this year's Circus kickoff. We shared lots of information and discussed numerous topics related to the 2021 Circus. At this time we would like to update the nobility on the Daddy tickets. As you all know, each Noble will receive 10 tickets at a cost of \$85 or \$8.50 each. It is important to understand that these Daddy tickets can be used to upgrade from a general admission to a reserved seat. For the purpose of upgrades, each Daddy ticket is worth the full value of a GA ticket, \$15. This means that for an additional \$10 a daddy ticket can be upgraded to a \$25 reserved seat. We are working with the MAC to get a limited number of prime reserved seats on consignment and these tickets will be available at the Tangier office during regular business hours. Thus, it will not be necessary to go to the MAC box office to upgrade the Daddy tickets, you can do it right at our Center. Moreover, the reserved seats will all be in the center section of the arena in several rows directly behind the area where we have the box seats, i.e., these upgrades will be in a prime location. These special reserved seat tickets will be available for all shows. Thus this is an opportunity to get a reserved seat in the center of the arena for \$18.50. Sounds like a win-win for both Tangier and our Nobility. Stay tuned for additional updates as we move forward.






