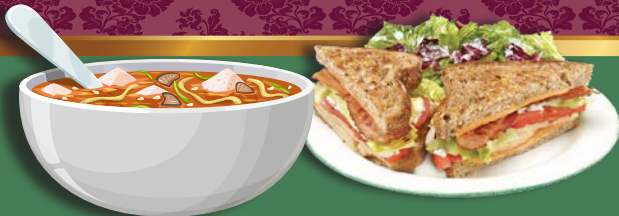

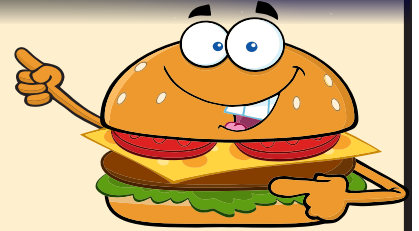

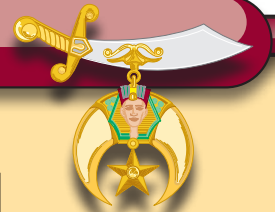

# Tangier Tales History that is Tangier

What's in a name? Shakespeare asked this question through the character of Juliet, in his play, Romeo and Juliet. Juliet responded to her question with, "a rose by any other name would smell as sweet." Shakespeare was essentially suggesting that a name, in and of itself, holds no real significance or defines a subject's true nature. The essence of something is more important than the label placed upon it. 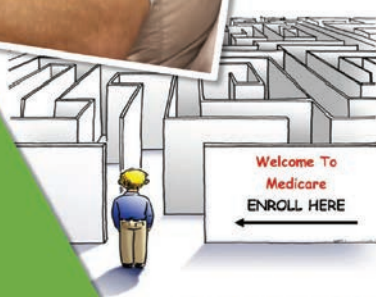
