- \$25,000 in various amounts of Scheels gift-cards will be given away.

What is the Sportsman's Raffle?

A quick look.

- The Sportsman's Raffle Event and ticket drawing will take place at Tangier (in the main room) Saturday, April 13th, 2024.
- Sponsorships are not only welcomed, but a **MUST** for this event to maximize its potential.

Raffle Tickets

- Only 2,000 tickets total.
- \$20 per ticket and will be sold starting at the kickoff event, until 11 AM the day of the drawing (Or when tickets sell-out. Whichever comes first).
- Tickets must be checked out via the committee or the office. You can also purchase tickets through the committee or Tangier office.

- Lunch starts at 11 am.
- All others can purchase a lunch for \$5 day of the event.

Day of Event

- Lunch will be cooked and served by the B&C Club.
- Cash bars will be available for beverage purchase. Proceeds go towards the Tangier General Fund.
- Tables with event sponsors spread out amongst the room with “side raffles” and info on their group, if they chose to participate.
- **TANGIER** will be doing 50/50 raffles during the event. Those proceeds will benefit the Tangier General Fund.



Drawing

- Raffle ticket drawing will begin @ 1 PM day of the event.
- All tickets drawn will be documented and if winners are present, can take their gift card home with them!
- If winner is not present, they will be contacted by the committee.

Sportsman's raffle fundraiser goals

- The goal of this event is to not only raise money for Tangier, but get our name out there plus get some prospective new members.
- With the 65% rule, we are more limited on what we can make, but this can still be a very good fundraiser, with minimal work required from the membership.
- The goal is to make a net revenue of \$25,000 for this year's raffle and event and grow that more and more each year.
